High Performance Teaching Teams: Integrating the Inquiry Cycle into PLCs

An important characteristic shared among High Performance Schools is the use of Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) to develop High Performance Teaching Teams. Teaching Teams, like any other team, can be either a High or Low Performance Team – this largely depends on their level of Engagement and Achievement as reflected in their internal culture and explicit team norms around the 4 KPIs of High Performance Teams.

Teaching Teams face significant additional demands given their core business of teaching students – whose learning needs fluctuate requiring teachers to continually adjust and refine classroom practice to maximise student outcomes. To address this unique professional demand, the 'Inquiry Cycle' is the most widely used framework for teacher development. In this presentation we share the work we have been doing in Australian Schools in integrating the Inquiry Cycle into the PLC Meeting Structures used by High Performance Teaching Teams.
